

# ENVIRONMENTAL RESPECT POLICY

---

Enerside Energy, S.A. ("Enerside") is a company committed to the continuous improvement of the company's internal processes, as well as to the social and environmental impacts that it generates, in all those areas and locations in which it has activity, presence and / or influence.

Enerside is a company whose economic activity focuses on the development, construction and operation of renewable electricity generation projects, mainly in South and Central America, the Caribbean and Spain. The operation is carried out directly by Enerside or by any company controlled by it in the different corporate forms legally in force ("Enerside Group"). In carrying out its activity, the Enerside Group engages with its own workers, local communities, suppliers, customers, business partners and other groups of interest. As a consequence of its business activity and its projects an impact is generated in the environment, both social, economic and environmental. One of the policy goals corporations is to improve these impacts.

The Corporate Policies contain the good practice guidelines that govern the actions of Enerside and of the companies that are part of the Enerside Group.

In application of the foregoing, the Board of Directors of Enerside is assigned the competence to design, evaluate and permanently review corporate governance and, specifically, to approve and update the Corporate Policies.

In the exercise of these responsibilities, the Board of Directors approves this Policy of Respect for the Environment (the "Policy"), which has been prepared taking into account the most demanding international standards.

## 1. Purpose

Enerside's Policy of Respect for the Environment is the comprehensive protection of all possible biodiversity systems with the aim of establishing a system for the protection of nature and the environment, both in the reflection of Enerside's actions in the environment and the impact produced in it by the rest of human society.

Enerside considers it essential that all its workforce have a maximum attitude of respect for the environment. For this reason, Enerside's commitment in this matter is absolutely aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) six, seven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen and seventeen approved by the United Nations Organization.

## 2. Scope of application

This Policy is applicable to all the members of the management team and the professionals of Enerside, the subsidiaries and branches and of the investee companies not integrated in Enerside over which Enerside has effective control.

In those investee companies in which Enerside does not hold a dominant position, Enerside will promote, through its representatives on its administrative bodies, the alignment of its policies with those of Enerside.

In addition, this Policy is also applicable, as appropriate, to joint ventures, temporary unions of companies and other equivalent associations, when Enerside assumes its management.

### 3. Basic principles of action

For this Policy to be truly effective, the Enerside team must adapt, as necessary, the actions related to the development and, mainly, the execution of its projects. In turn, Enerside has a solid commitment to continuously improve its environmental environment and, where appropriate, collaborate with local communities to minimize the impact of its projects.

In accordance with the foregoing, this Policy establishes the following Guiding Principles:

- Integrate environmental protection as a main pillar of Enerside's action, in parallel to the concept of sustainable development, using documented scientific criteria so that all this is applied in planning processes, decision-making and / or processes of analysis of new opportunities of business.
- Maintain a permanent exhaustive control of compliance with current legislation, Enerside internal regulations and carry out periodic evaluations of the environmental performance and safety of its facilities.
- Establish the management systems necessary to achieve excellence in environmental protection, with the main instruction on pollution prevention.
- Use energy resources and raw materials in a sustainable way with the environment, ensuring that Enerside's suppliers apply these criteria, as well as measuring and reducing Enerside's environmental impact through the application of best existing practices, regardless of analysis. cost-benefit.
- Protect, conserve and promote biodiversity in all ecosystems in which there is a presence with the objective of "no loss" of biodiversity. Contribute to the fight against climate change through decarbonization through the development of our business activity to promote energy renewable.
- Require the implementation of environmental policies to its contractors and providers based on these same principles, covering all processes throughout its value chain.

### 4. Control and evaluation

Control of the application of this Policy corresponds to the Sustainability Committee.


