

## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

---

Enerside Energy, SA (“Enerside”) is a company committed to the continuous improvement of the company's internal processes, as well as the social and environmental impacts it generates, in all those areas and locations in which it has activity, presence and /or influence.

Enerside is a company whose economic activity is focused on the development, construction and operation of renewable electricity generation projects, mainly in Latin America, Italy and Spain. The operation is carried out directly by Enerside or by any company controlled by it in the different corporate forms legally in force (“Enerside Group”). In the development of its activity, the Enerside Group establishes its relationship with its own workers, local communities, suppliers, customers, business partners and other stakeholders.

The Corporate Policies contain the good practice guidelines that govern the actions of Enerside and of the companies integrated in the Enerside Group.

Pursuant to the foregoing, Enerside's Board of Directors is empowered to permanently design, assess and review corporate governance and, specifically, to approve and update Corporate Policies.

In the exercise of these responsibilities, the Board of Directors approves this Environmental Policy (the “Policy”), which has been prepared taking into account the most demanding international standards.

### 1. Purpose

Enerside's Environmental Policy is the comprehensive protection of all possible biodiversity systems with the aim of establishing a system for the protection of nature and the environment, both as a reflection of Enerside's actions in the environment and the impact it produces on the same as the rest of human society.

Enerside considers it essential that all its work personnel have a maximum attitude of respect for the environment. Therefore, Enerside's commitment in this area is absolutely aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) six, seven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, and seventeen approved by the United Nations.

### 2. Scope

This Policy is applicable to all members of the management team and professionals of Enerside, the subsidiaries and branches and non-Enerside investee companies over which Enerside has effective control.

In those affiliated companies in which Enerside does not hold a dominant position, Enerside will promote, through its representatives in its administrative bodies, the alignment of its policies with those of Enerside.

### 3. Basic principles of action

In order for this Policy to be truly effective, the Enerside team must adapt, as necessary, the actions related to the development and, mainly, the execution of its projects. In turn, Enerside has a strong commitment to continuously improve its environmental surroundings and, where appropriate, collaborate with local communities to minimize the impact of its projects.

In accordance with the foregoing, this Policy establishes the following Guiding Principles:

- Integrate the protection of the environment as a main pillar of Enerside's action, in parallel to the concept of sustainable development, using documented scientific criteria so that all of this is applied in planning processes, decision making and/or analysis processes of new business opportunities.
- Maintain a permanent exhaustive control of compliance with current legislation, Enerside's internal regulations and carry out periodic evaluations of the environmental behavior and safety of its facilities.
- Establish the necessary management systems to achieve excellence in environmental protection, with the main instruction of pollution prevention.
- Using energy resources and raw materials in an environmentally sustainable manner, ensuring that Enerside's suppliers apply these criteria, as well as measuring and reducing Enerside's environmental impact by applying existing best practices.
- Protect, conserve, and promote biodiversity in all ecosystems in which to have a presence in order to preserve it.
- Contribute to the fight against climate change by raising awareness and seeking measures aimed at:
  - i. decarbonization through the development of our business activity for the promotion of renewable energies;
  - ii. the reduction of emissions, both greenhouse gases (GHG) and others (non- GHG),
  - iii. waste reduction; and
  - iv. the reduction of water use.
- Regularly publish environmental indicators so that our stakeholders can monitor the evolution of the company in environmental matters.
- Recommend the implementation of environmental policies to our contractors, suppliers and other stakeholders, based on these same principles, that cover all processes throughout the value chain.

#### 4. Control and evaluation


The control of the application of this Policy corresponds to the Sustainability Committee.

Likewise, Enerside, through its Integrated Management System Committee and the Management Bodies, will periodically review the IMS, detect areas for improvement and define and implement the Action Plan to meet environmental objectives.

The evaluation of the application of this Policy corresponds to the Sustainability Committee which, at least once a year, will evaluate the compliance and effectiveness of this Policy.
